of physical play which suited both teams (25' in particular). The referee had a couple of big foul/non foul decisions to make during the match, the first being the award of a penalty kick to Aston Villa on 10 minutes for a foul committed by Lee Cattermole. This was the correct decision as the defender had his arms all over the attacker, preventing him from gaining possession of the ball. Just moments before, Madley was seen speaking to players in the penalty area before the taking of a corner yet the Sunderland player still chose to illegally stop the attacker. The second crucial decision was to refuse a second penalty claim for Aston Villa on 78 minutes, instead cautioning the attacker for simulation. I am prepared to back the referee's decision here as no replay picked up any contact between the two players. Madley attempted to let the game flow where possible & played some good advantages, but was not afraid to pull the play back when required (13').
