

At the same time he was ready to bring back play and punish the initial infringement if that was required. However the referee missed 3 clear fouls (12', 14', 61'). There was only 1 crucial scene at the match at min. 07'. Diego Costa and Fernandinho challenge the ball inside the penalty area. Diego Costa gets to the ball first and he seems to have a contact with Fernandinho. However the CHE attacker doesn't fall instantly and does a step before going into the ground. Referee waives play-on. After reviewing the replay, I agree

with the referee's decision.
